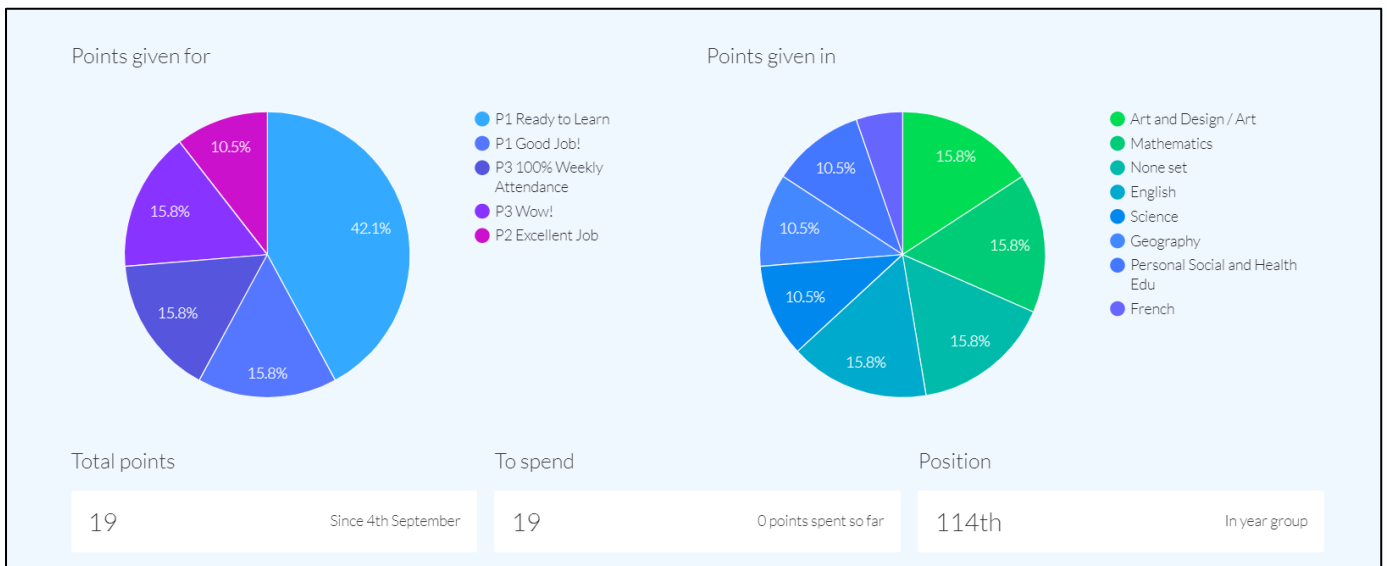
Dear Parent / Carer

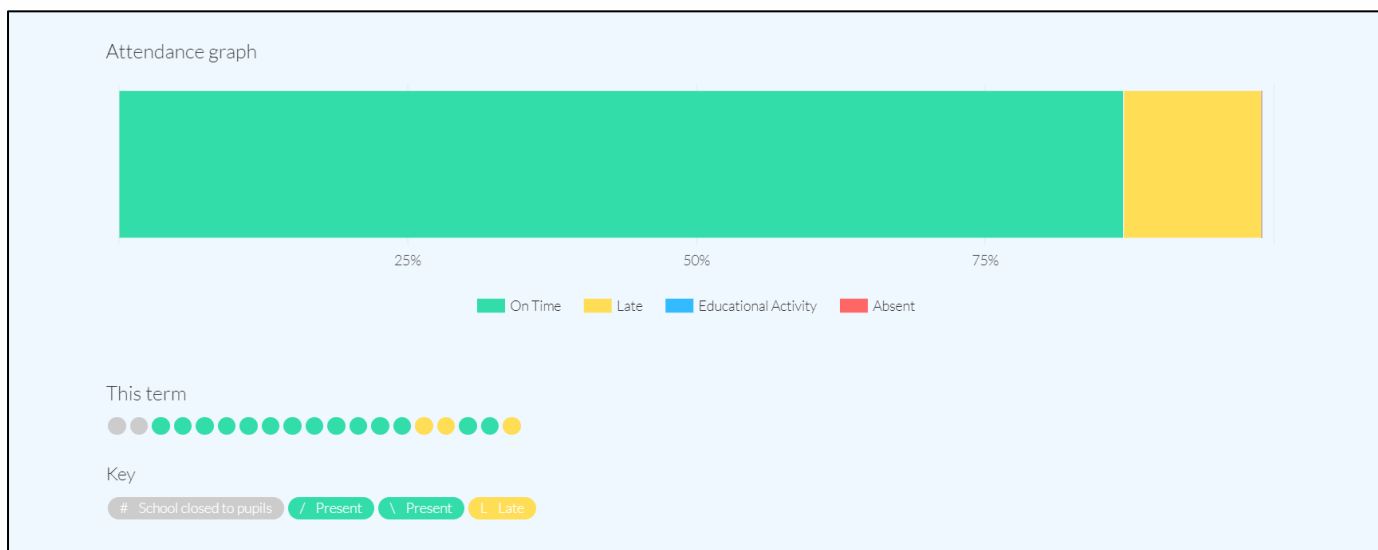

On ePraise, you will be able to see your child's:

- Timetable





You will receive an email inviting you to “register” onto our e-Praise site. By clicking in the link on the email, you will need to set up a password. You can log on and find this information from your PC, Mac, tablet or smartphone. Simply follow the instructions for instructions for [registering on e-Praise](#).

You can also access the e-Praise platform via any web-enabled device or via the Epraise mobile app (available on iOS and Android). Using and navigating through the Epraise platform is straight forward, however, please feel free to refer to [the e-Praise guide](#) for easy-to-follow instructions.
