Dear Parents/Carers and Year 11 students,

Firstly, a huge well done to students for persevering and adopting such a positive attitude towards your ongoing assessments and thank you to parents and carers for your support.

As you are aware Year 11 will continue in **compulsory education** until Friday 25<sup>th</sup> June and as such attendance is mandatory.

We have planned the three weeks carefully with significant financial investment to procure high quality provision and students will hopefully find them both beneficial and enjoyable. As a school we realise the importance of supporting our students as they transition through education and we would like to give them the necessary skills to do successfully. Therefore, we will be covering the cost at £25 per student.

On the days when students are expected on site we will register them in school. On the days when they are working remotely at home they should use the Check-In App in their Tutor Group Teams to register **before 10am**. This is vital so we can keep in touch, check on students' welfare and avoid having to contact parents regarding students' attendance.

For the first 2 weeks students will be taking part in the National Citizenship Scheme (NCS). This is a nationally recognized government initiative for those aged 16-17 and supports the transition from Year 11 to college. It's a great way for young people to learn the skills for work and life they need to succeed in the future, whilst having an enjoyable experience. NCS is all about helping teenagers realise their potential, by giving them a taste for independence, whilst learning new skills so they can go on to achieve their future goals. We will register students for this programme in tutor time this week.

Students will need to come dressed in their PE kit or in smart black jogging bottoms and a black t-shirt.
